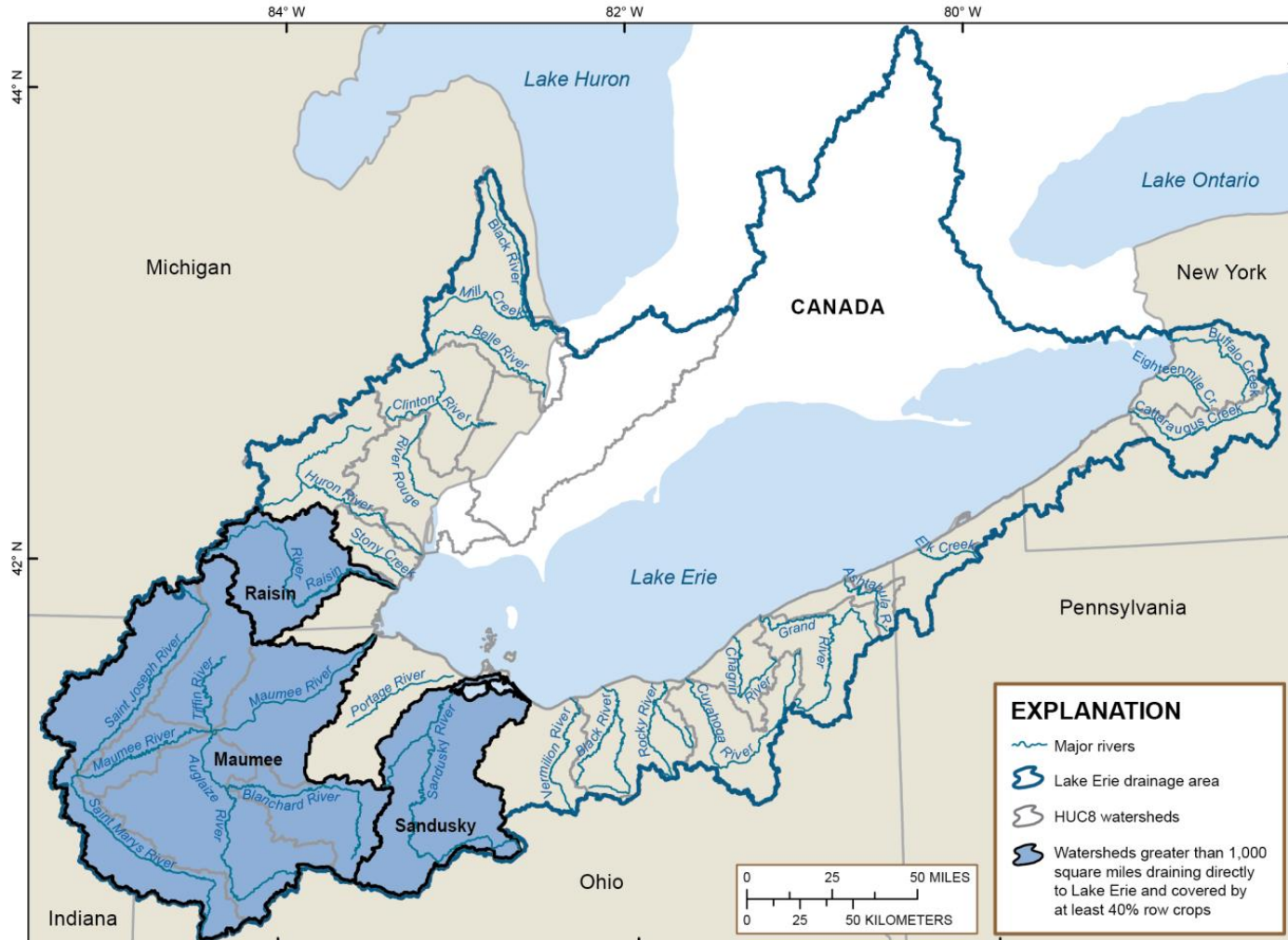

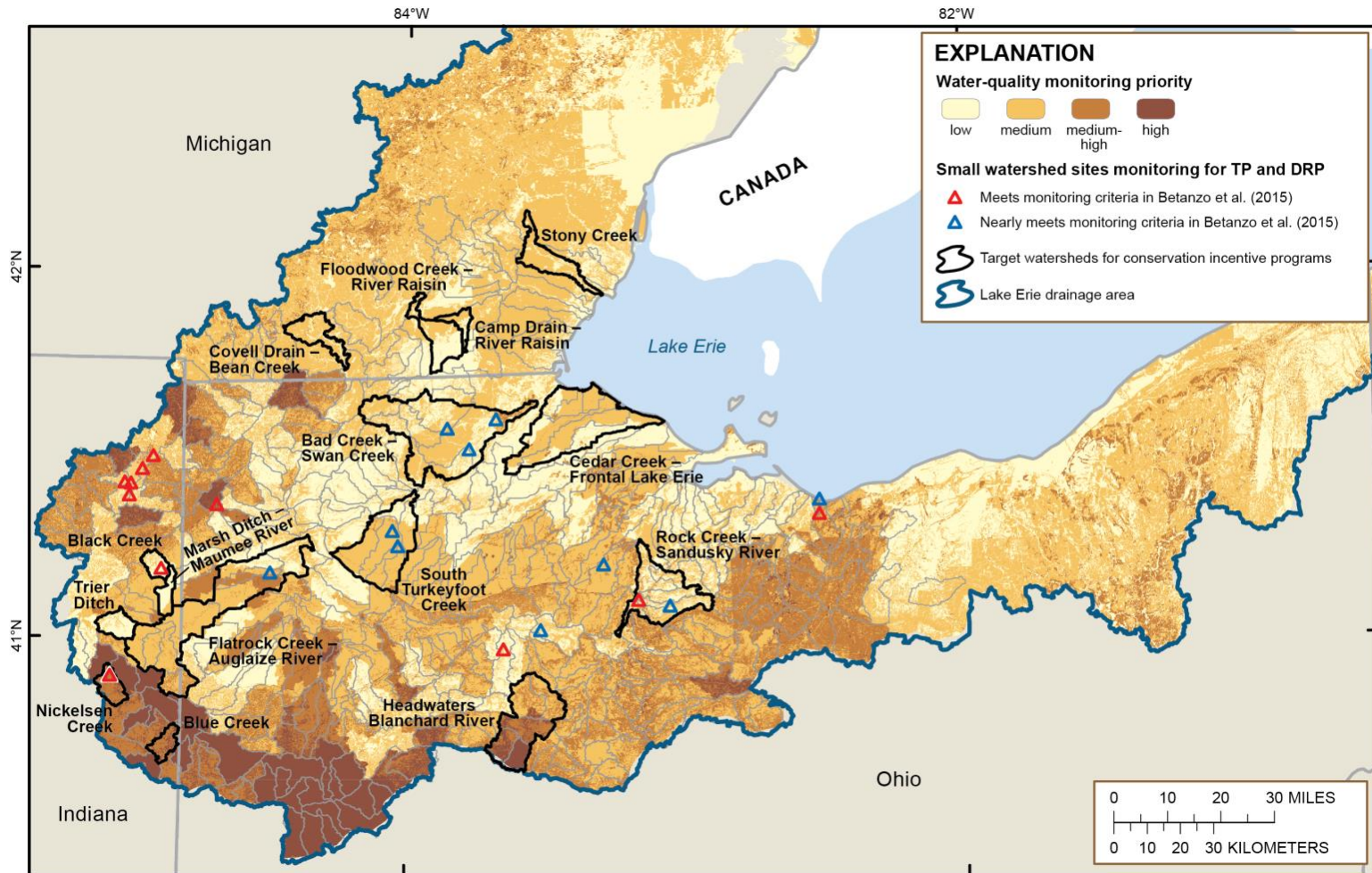


Large Watersheds: Right Data in the Right Places





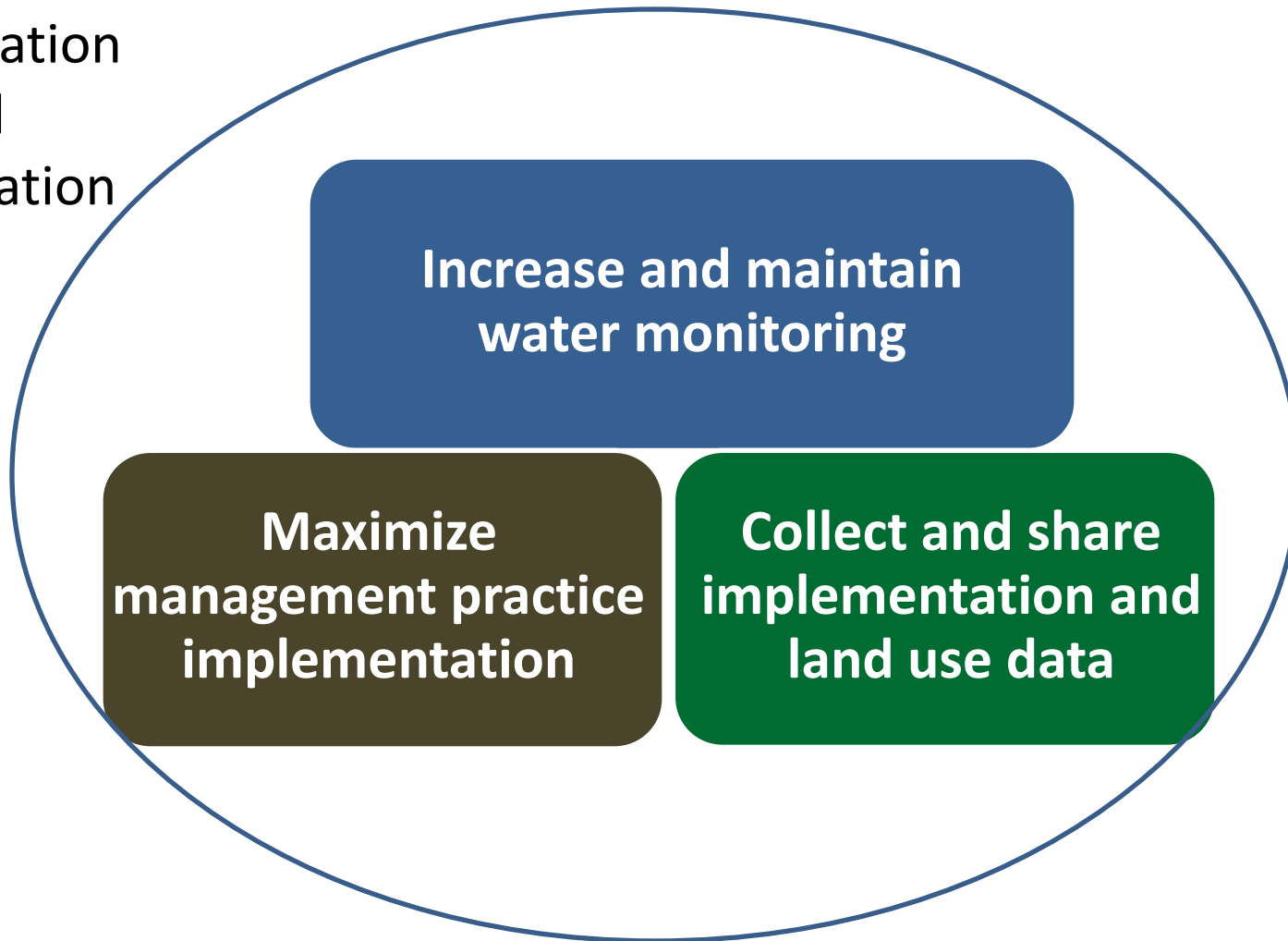
Small Watersheds: Right Data But Not in the Right Places
