What is a P3?



- Public-Private Partnerships, PPPs or P3s are partnerships between the public and private sector to build public infrastructure like roads, hospitals or schools as well as deliver services
- P3s can be structured in different ways, allocating varying degrees of responsibility for design, construction, financing, maintenance, and sometimes operation to the private sector for periods of 25-35 years


What is a P3?




- P3s are publicly-owned and controlled
- The government contracts with a single entity ("Project Co") who in turn contracts with consortium partners
- P3s are performance-based
 - Payment from Government only begins upon completion of construction, and on-going payments remain subject to deduction for failures in service delivery

When to use P3s




Typical characteristics that make a project more likely to make sense as a P3:

- Project is large in size (\$50M Capital Expenditure or higher)
- Project is complex
- The opportunity for risk transfer by the government owner
- Long-term maintenance and/or operations component
- Opportunity to innovate
