The NOAA Marine Debris Program "Marine Debris Removal" federal funding opportunity Due October 29, 2018

Projects awarded through the removal grant competition will create long-term, quantifiable ecological habitat improvements for NOAA trust resources, with priority consideration for efforts targeting derelict fishing gear and other medium- and large-scale debris. Projects should also foster public awareness of the effects of marine debris to further the conservation of resources and habitats, and contribute to the understanding of marine debris composition, distribution and impacts.

Municipalities outside of Quebec – submission deadline: October 23, 2018

The call for applications for asset management grants will close on October 23, 2018 for all non-Quebec municipalities. Accepting application submissions until Tuesday, October 23, 2018 at midnight EDT, or until funding is fully allocated.

Quebec municipalities – submission deadline: April 1, 2019 Due to delays in the funding process for Quebec municipalities, applications for direct funding through

MAMP will be accepted until Sunday, April 1, 2019 at midnight EDT.
