FOUNDED IN 2003, we are a multinational coalition of mayors and local government and Indigenous leaders representing more than 400 communities. Our member communities represent over 22 million people across the region, spanning from Duluth, Minnesota to Gaspé, Quebec.

As an organization, we work to prepare our members to tackle some of the region's most pressing challenges head-on and leverage some of the unique opportunities that come from being in the Great Lakes and St. Lawrence River Region—which contains over 80 percent of North America's fresh water and represents over \$8 trillion in annual economic activity.

The Action Plan presents a vision for developing the Fresh Coast Economic Corridor that unites efforts for economic development from Lake Superior to the Gulf of the St. Lawrence.
